High School Students Dedicate Literary Magazine to Fighting Climate Change Fall Issue to Include Interviews and Articles from Bill McKibben and Notable Environmentalists

In February of 2023, AND Literary was established as a magazine in which student writers and artists could marry their respective passions by pairing writing pieces with custom artwork, thereby gaining work experience. The three teams (Editors,

Designers, and Artists) work together to produce a professional-quality magazine each quarter.

The upcoming issue addresses climate change, featuring Bill McKibben (environmentalist and New York Times-bestselling author), Faatiha Ayat (12-year-old activist and CEO of the CHIL&D non-profit), as well as Serge Hoyda (president of Clean Air Zone). AND Literary has opened submissions to students, faculty, parents, and alumni nationwide for this issue only. They are specifically looking for pieces that focus on climate change and nature but accept writing and art centered on all themes.

In an exclusive interview, McKibben stated, "Greta Thunberg is an old friend, and one of the best climate warriors—but she'd be the first to say there are 10,000 Greta's scattered around the world... We need more!" Using artwork and writing, AND Literary aspires to mobilize our society by making the climate crisis the primary issue on people's minds. Climate change isn't a possibility; it's here and AND Literary wants to end it.
